

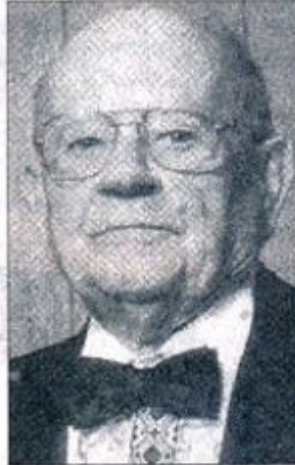
## Walter Hugh Lee, Jr.
